- Culturally Responsive: Respecting family culture and background
- Inclusive Practice: Children with disability join all activities
- Key Worker: Main person coordinating support
- Multi-disciplinary Practice: Different professionals working together
- SMART Goals: Clear goals that are Specific, Measurable,
 Achievable, Realistic, Timely 6
- Consent: Permission from a parent or carer 🦾
- Near Miss: Something could have caused harm but didn't

Principles **F**

1. Every child can join activities with friends 😂

- 2. Families are part of all decisions
 3. Focus on what children and families can do
 4. Use research-based methods
- 5. Include children in natural routines and community
- 6. Only qualified Social Workers provide ECI 🧍
- 7. Support children to take safe risks 📍
- 8. Check and reduce risks 1

How We Do This 🛠

1. Planning and Assessment 🗐

- Make a plan with the family and child
- Identify risks and record them
- Align plans with goals and strengths **
- Review plans when new NDIS plan comes or changes happen

2. Interventions 🔆

- Teach parents and carers
- Assess children to guide support 🖔
- Coordinate services with Key Worker
- Work with other professionals
- Help children develop skills like communication, problemsolving, self-reflection, mindfulness

3. Learning Styles 🞨

- Visual: Learn with pictures or colours
- Kinaesthetic: Learn by doing
- Aural: Learn by listening 👂
- Social: Learn in groups 👥
- Solitary: Learn alone
- Verbal: Learn with words
- Logical: Learn with reasoning 🔆

4. Tools and Resources 🛠

- Use child-friendly language 🗣
- Use visual aids and routines
- Work in natural environments
- Tailor support to each child 🌞

5. Key Worker Model 📋

- Families may have a Key Worker 🧥
- Staff must keep skills and registration up to date

6. Inclusion 🌈

- Children join home, community, and early learning 6 4 \$\infty\$
- Educate networks to include children

7. Collaboration 🤝

- Work with families, carers, and professionals
- Record changes, entries, and exits

Consider child's views in transitions
Use consent forms

8. Outcome-Based Approach 6

- Use SMART goals aligned with family priorities 6
- Review plans annually or sooner if needed 🔄

9. Feedback and Improvement 🛸

- Families give feedback \bigcirc
- Reflect and improve services continuously

- **Director**: Make sure policy is followed ✓
- Social Workers: Assess risks, provide interventions
- Office Manager: Keep records safe 🔒
- All Staff: Follow procedures and include children
