What some words mean






- ◆ *Infection*: When germs make you sick .
- ◆ *Infection Control*: Steps we take to stop germs spreading .
- ◆ *Standard Precautions*: Everyday safety steps like washing hands  and cleaning .
- ◆ *PPE*: Safety gear like gloves , masks , and gowns .
- ◆ *Outbreak*: More people getting sick than usual .

- ✓ Stop infections from spreading  
- ✓ Teach people how to stay safe 
- ✓ Provide cleaning and safety supplies  
- ✓ Act quickly if someone is sick  
- ✓ Follow health and safety laws  

Who does what






Management

- Train staff in infection control 
- Give staff PPE and cleaning products  
- Check everyone is following the rules 
- Tell staff and participants about any risks 

Staff, Contractors, Volunteers






- Follow infection control rules 
- Wear PPE properly 
- Report if anyone is sick  
- Keep things clean 
- Help participants with hygiene 

Participants




- Wash hands and follow hygiene steps  
- Tell staff if feeling unwell 
- Stay home or isolate if sick  

What we do

Hand Hygiene



 Wash hands or use sanitiser before/after helping people  , eating  , cleaning  , or using PPE  .

2 PPE

 Wear gloves, masks, or other gear when needed  

 Throw away single-use PPE properly 


3 Cleaning

 Clean and disinfect surfaces every day 

 Keep cleaning records 



4 Illness

 Tell staff if unwell 

 Sick people don't do face-to-face work 

 Remote support can be offered 

5 Vaccinations

 Staff and participants are encouraged to get vaccines 

6 Outbreaks

 Report outbreaks to management and health authorities 

 Extra cleaning and safety steps will happen  

7 Training

 Staff are trained when they start  and refreshed each year



8 Records

 Keep notes about training  , cleaning  , PPE  , and any sickness
