Why we have this policy 🥕



- We want everyone at Soaring Sparrows to stay safe when taking medication.
- Staff will not give or manage medication unless they are a credentialed carer.

Who this is for

- Participants
- 器 Families or guardians
- Credentialed carers (trained health or care professionals)
- Staff, volunteers, and contractors

What some words mean

Medication: Any medicine, prescription or over-the-counter



Self-Administration: Participant takes their own medication



- Credentialed Carer: A trained professional who can give medication &
- Family Support: A parent, guardian, or family member helps with medication 🎇
- Emergency Situation: A serious reaction to medication needing urgent help 🕍

Our promise

- Keep participants safe with medication •
- ✓ Only allow medication to be managed by participants, family, or credentialed carers
- Staff will watch and report issues but will not give or prompt medication X

What we do

1 Assessment of Medication Needs

- Support Coordinators check if participants need medication while using services
- Make plans for self-administration, family support, or credentialed carers

Communication

- Participants or families must tell staff about medication needs before programs
- Report any concerns to the Director

Monitoring and Observation

- Staff may watch participants take medication
- X Staff do not help unless it is a medical emergency 👗
- Report any problems to family, responsible person, or credentialed carer

Documentation

- Note any medication issues in case notes
- Record if participant needs extra help planning their medication schedule

- Emergency Situations
- 准 If a participant has a serious reaction (e.g., allergy, overdose)
- Call emergency services immediately
- Follow emergency procedures

Who does what

- Participant Manage their medication safely or get support
- **Family/Guardian** Help participant and tell staff about changes
- Credentialed Carer Give medication safely if authorised and report issues
- **Staff** Watch, report issues, follow emergency steps, but do not give medication
